CHUSY REGIONAL GENERAL BOARD POSITIONS

ATHLETICS

These chairpersons are responsible for supervising the Regional Basketball League, as well as any other sports activities the Region undertakes. This includes attending and running scoring at all CHUSY basketball games.

CAMP CHUSY

These chairpersons will serve as the planning force of Camp CHUSY. They will plan, organize, publicize and execute all aspects of the encampment. These chairpersons need to be available during the summer.

CHICAGOLAND JEWISH HIGH SCHOOL AND SOLOMON SCHECHTER DAY SCHOOL OUTREACH

These chairpersons shall act as the USY liaisons to the Chicagoland Jewish High School and will help develop ways to include and promote USY and Kadima at the Chicagoland Jewish High School and Solomon Schechter Day School, respectively. Additionally, these chairpersons shall act as USY liaisons at SSDS Shabbatonim.

CHUSYFEST

These chairpersons will serve as the planning force of CHUSYFEST. They will plan, organize, publicize, and execute all aspects of the program.

FRESHMAN LIAISONS

These representatives shall be responsible for Freshman outreach and retention from Kadima. They may also plan Freshman programming for the year.

ISRAEL AWARENESS

This committee shall coordinate Israel programs for the Region in addition to organizing and editing an Israel awareness newsletter. HeChalutzim programs and activities also fall under this position.

ISRAEL SHABBATON

This chairperson(s) shall be responsible for planning programming for the CHUSY Israel Shabbaton.

KADIMA KONVENTION

These chairpersons are responsible for developing programming with Kadima-aged young people and working on relationships between USY and Kadima. Their main responsibility is planning and attending the CHUSY Region Kadima Konvention, for 6th-8th grader Kadimaniks.

KESHER

This person will be helping out with CHUSY's New Special Needs Program, "Keshet". This person will assist the Keshet Director with programming and help "connect" the entire CHUSY community.

KINNUS

These chairpersons will serve as the planning force of KINNUS. They will plan, organize, publicize, and execute all aspects of the program.

ON-LINE SERVICES

This chairperson will manage a Regional web page, aid chapters in developing web pages, and serve as correspondent to the International On-Line Chairperson.

PUBLIC SCHOOL OUTREACH

These chairpersons will act as liaisons from the USYers from public school to the Regional Executive Board. It will be their job to make sure that the needs of each USYer from Public School are getting tended to. In addition to this, it will also be the Public School Outreach Committee's job to create advertising and programming that will attract teens from Public School to CHUSY.

NEWSLETTER-HARAKEVET

The editor(s) will be responsible for putting out the regional newspaper on a regular basis. This includes all set-up, collection of articles, photos, etc.

RELIGION/EDUCATION

This committee will be responsible for the development of new religious materials for the chapters. This also includes working with the Religion/Education VP of each chapter to strengthen their religious programming as well as assisting with the religious aspects of regional programs.

RUACH

This committee will be responsible for preparing ruach songs for conventions on Friday and Saturday evenings. This includes a preset list of songs, choosing songs to teach the region, and working with the Religion/Education Vice President to maximize overall appreciation for and love of zmirot and Ruach sessions at conventions and regional programs.

SENIOR PROGRAMMING

Chairperson is responsible for planning senior programs throughout the year as well as at regional events.

SHABBAT ENHANCEMENT

Chairperson is responsible for encouraging the observance and meaning of Shabbat through a variety of programs and activities.

SOCIAL ACTION/TIKUN OLAM

This committee is responsible for educating USYers about social action issues, promoting creative programs and projects with regards to Tikun Olam and Social Action, and to assist with all Regional SA/TO endeavors. Additionally, this committee will plan, organize, publicize, and execute all aspects of the Regional mitzvah program for Social Action/Tikun Olam, known as SA/TO Marathon.

YEARBOOK

Editor(s) will be in charge of production of the Regional yearbook, which shall include articles, artwork, editing, etc. Taking pictures at Regional and Chapter programs shall be included.
